



# **Arlington Ice Hockey Club**

## **Player/Parent/Guardian Contract**

### **2010-2011 Season**

As a participant on the Arlington Wild Hockey team and member of the Arlington Ice Hockey Club, all players and parents/guardians shall be subject to the following AIHC rules while participating in the program. If rules are broken, players and/or parents/guardians will be subject to disciplinary measures, which could include benching, suspension from practices and/or games, or non-refundable dismissal from the Arlington Wild Ice Hockey Club or team.

### **Players:**

#### **The Arlington Ice Hockey Club will not tolerate the following behavior:**

- Disrespect to officials, coaches, rink personnel, parents or players including:
  - Profanity
  - Fighting
  - Hazing
- Theft or vandalism. Locker rooms will be cleaned before and after each game.
- Illegal use of drugs, alcohol, tobacco, or the use of performance enhancing drugs.
- Locker boxing.

#### **“No pass no play”**

“No pass no play” applies to the AIHC Varsity/ Junior Varsity teams in compliance with the AT&T Metroplex High School Hockey League regulations. Academic grades below 70 (honors/AP classes below 60) following AISD rules will result in game suspensions. Progress reports reflecting grade improvements to better than 70 will reinstate game participation. After each six week grading period, a copy of the player’s report card shall be provided to the VP-Hockey Operations. Copies will be made for the Coach.

#### **Games and Practices, Players are to:**

- Conduct themselves in a manner that will bring only respect and honor to the Arlington Wild hockey team both on and off the ice.
- Arrive at practice no later than 30 minutes prior to the start of practice when dryland training is not scheduled.
- Arrive at practice no later than 60 minutes prior to the start of practice when dryland training is scheduled.
- Are to be ready to take the ice 10 minutes prior to the start of practice.
- Wear practice jerseys issued by the Arlington Wild .
- Contact their respective Coach if you will miss or be late to practice.
- Arrive at the rink at least 1 hour prior to the start of their game.
- Participate in warm ups which will begin 50 minutes prior to the start of their game.
- Wear warm up suits issued by the Arlington Wild. NOTE: No hats
- Wear Wild logo T-shirts, and tennis shoes during warm ups. . Until the weather cools off players should bring a pair of athletic shorts to wear for warm ups. NOTE: No skateboard shoes.
- Wear black, or dark blue helmets, gloves and breezers for games. NOTE: No torn Breezers.
- Wear only socks and game jerseys issued by the Arlington Wild.
- Players will not be allowed to play if missing any of these.
- To honor a 10:30pm curfew on the night before a game.
- Contact respective Coach if you will miss or be late to a game (24 hour advance notice.)

## **Parents/Guardians:**

- I understand that it is the responsibility of team coaches and assistant coaches to assign positions and allocate playing time.
- Team or coaching issues should be a discussion between the player and the Coach first. If that does not resolve the issue, the parent can call or email the Coach.
- I agree with the Player rules above and will support my player in complying with them.
- I will wait 24 hours before contacting coaches about my players participation in a game.
- I will go through the appropriate procedure for filing complaints
- I will not be disrespectful to officials, coaches, rink personnel, parents or players.

## **League Fees:**

The 2010-2011 season league fees are estimated to be \$2,200.00 per player. With Board recommendation and a Parent majority vote, the amount could change. As most of the AIHC expenses are fixed, the following applies to the annual fee:

- Payments scheduled as follows:
  - \$600.00 8/31/10
  - \$600.00 10/5/10
  - \$500.00 11/2/10
  - \$500.00 12/7/10
- Reductions in the annual fee will not be allowed for a player that cannot attend all practices or games due to other activities that have conflicting schedules.
- Per the guidelines above, any player suspended or dismissed from AIHC for cause will not receive refunds.
- Sideline injuries will be reviewed by the Board on a case-by-case basis for fee reduction consideration.
- New players (that have never been on the Arlington Wild team) that join after the season has started might receive a prorated fee.
- “No pay no play”-players that are delinquent on a payment and have not sought payment plan alternatives through a request submitted to the Board, will be benched for games and practices until payments are paid current.

**If rules are broken, I understand that I, the player or parent/guardian, will be subject to disciplinary measures which could include prohibition from attending AIHC practices, games, and tournaments, or dismissal from AIHC.**
